Let's Overcome Disabilities Together Against Disasters project is funded within the scope of Erasmus+ programme. Main objective of the project is to increase awareness level of impaired people as enabling them to be ready in case of any emergency.

Target group of our project is consist of visually psysically, and hearing-impaired people in local, national and international level as well as support people in disability networks.

Development of Project's Main Idea

Regarding 10. amendment of constitutional law, the government is given the responsibility of providing equal rights to disabled citizens for precautions to be taken in disasters and emergency. Besides, there is no existing disaster training module specifically designed to meet disabled citizens' needs, and accessibility to similar resources is limited. Therefore, priority has been given to projects and applications submitted, and implemented which aim to help disadvantaged groups. In the light of all these points, disabled people are the most disadvantaged group in society, and the main idea was developed with the idea of providing equal rights to access preparing and preventing opportunities against disasters.

According to data of World Health Organization (WHO) in 2011, 15% of world's population, more than 1 billion, is consist of disabled people. This rate constitutes for 6.6%, 4 million people, for Turkey. (Population and Residence Research, Turkish Statistical Institute, 2011)

Beyond its statistical importance, it is observed that disabled citizens face obstacles for reaching public opportunities. Correspondingly, need for a sustainable, safe disaster management system is revealed, and the project is shaped regarding the Stakeholders Analysis.

Project Outcomes


4 final outcomes are planned for the project, and all activities are planned accordingly.

- 1) Distance Education Module:** An online training module which enables disabled people to use it according to their disabilities is developed by E-learning portal. The module is prepared in 5 different languages (Czech, Polish, English, Turkish, and Bulgarian) because the project has an international level. 2) **Practice Simulation Module:** The module contains written and visual training materials (videos, photos, printed booklets) which provide information about how to be prepared to disasters and what to do during any disaster specified for each disaster and disability type. Materials are prepared according to accessibility of disabled citizens regarding their disability types in English, and national language of partner organizations. With the co-operation of Eskişehir AFAD and Anadolu University, a survey, consist of 41 questions, is prepared to identify level of disaster and emergency awareness of people. The survey is delivered to disability associations operating in Eskişehir, various training centers, and students studying in Anadolu University Distanced Education Faculty via online portal.

1801 individuals participated to this survey. According to the results, 62% of disabled people has not taken any disaster training. Also, it is revealed that 85% of disabled people believe that their awareness has increased, and 84% believes that the project outcomes will be beneficial for themselves. Research results:
